## Step 1) Analysts' Ratings \& Forecasts

## Sentiment Score

Add one point for score 0 to +4 . Subtract one point for score below -3 or above 8 .
Earnings Growth
Subtract one point if forecast Y-O-Y EPS growth below 15\%.
Earnings Forecast Trend
Disqualify if current FY EPS trend down $\$ 0.03$ three cents or more.
Earnings Surprise History
Disqualify if two of the last four earnings surprises negative.

## Step 2) Valuation

Add one point for PEG 1.1 to 1.4. Subtract one point for PEG above 2.0

## Step 3) Target Price

Subtract one point if current price exceeds low target buy price.

## Step 4) Industry Analysis

Industry Growth
Add one point if growth rate exceeds $20 \%$.Subtract one point if less than $10 \%$.
Industry Concentration
Add one point if the industry has less than five major competitors.

## Step 5) Business Plan

Record business plan score (max: -4 to +4 )
Step 6) Management Quality
Key Executive \& Board Quality
Add one point key exec $\&$ board quality rated very good or excellent.
Clean Accounting/Earnings Growth Stability
Subtract one point if non-recurring exceeds 3\% of sales or poor EPS stability.

## Step 7) Financial Health

Disqualify candidates that fail appropriate test.

## Step 8) Profitability

## Sales Growth

Add one point if Y-O-Y sales growth exceeds $25 \%$., subtract one point if below15\%.
Operating Margins
Disqualify candidate if operating margins deteriorating.

## Return on Assets

Add one point if ROA exceeds $14 \%$. Subtract one point if ROA below 6\%
Operating Cash Flow
Disqualify if OCF was negative in two of last three fiscal years.

## Step 9) Red Flags

Red Flags
Disqualify if any red flags detected.
Yellow Flags
Subtract one point for each yellow flag

## Step 10) Ownership

Institutional Ownership
Disqualify if institutional ownership below 30\%
Insider Ownership
Subtract one point if insider ownership above 55\%
Step 11) Price Chart
Share Price vs. Moving Average
Subtract one point if price below 200-day MA or more than $50 \%$ above
